You can apply for reimbursement for the following activities. **DEADLINE is August 31.**

Bonspiels – <u>two</u> entry fees per year – need to tell which bonspiel and your portion of the entry fee, copy of canceled check or include an entry form.

Playdowns – half of your entry fee – submit a copy of your online USCA fees.

Nationals/U-18/Jr Olympic Trials – \$100 per curler, <u>only if</u> expenses exceed fundraising. Expense reports and fundraising information <u>must</u> be provided.

Curling Camp – half of the camp registration fee – this will be confirmed with the camp directors. If there are funds at the end of August, this will extend to HP camps.
